#### Non-formal education trough arts -project

Due to covid-19 pandemic in 2020-2022 almost all Drums for Peace related projects were postponed. Despite problems with travel and flight tickets the Non-formal education trough arts (NFETA) -project was implemented during 2021 and 2022.

Participants from 11 countries representing 12 organizations interrested in using participatione arts and Drums for peace methodology gathered in 2 mobilities at Akaa, Finland in order to build up (rebuild) a network around the matter and plan new exchange projects and trainings for young people and youth workers.

The first mobility in this project took place in late august 2021. The history and methodology of Drums for Peace was presented and 3 open workshops run by DFP artists Clara, Davide and Antti were offered in order to give participants an experience of the methodology. This was followed by intensive planning of future projects. This took place at hostel Suomenlinna in Suomenlinna island in front of Helsinki.

By february a couple of projects were already applied from which Gnistan got their application approved and Youth for future -project was implemented in august 2022.

The second mobility took place in late august beginning september this year. Participants were writing applications together for youth exchanges and trainings for the coming round in october.Participants expressed a strong will to continue cooperation and strenghten the network.

Next meeting (2023) was agreed to be applied as soon as possible. This will be applied and hosted by Slupski Osrodek Kultury in Slupsk, Poland. Approximately 10 projects were planned to be applied in coming october and february 2023
